WomenInvest Portfolio examples

Pax Ellevate Global Women's Index Fund (PXWIX)

The strategy is the first broadly diversified mutual fund investing in the highest-rated companies in the world for advancing women through gender-diverse boards, senior leadership teams, and other policies and practices.

Self-Help Credit Union: Women and Children Term Certificate

The Self-Help Credit Union supports women who are building assets by opening their first savings accounts, starting their own businesses, or buying homes. This support has resulted in women holding 39% of total credit union loans and more than 1,200 loans to womenowned businesses.

Addressing family violence

In addition to supporting opportunities for women and families through investments, Thrivent Charitable addresses domestic violence against women through a variety of strategies:

- CCM Community Impact Bond Fund (CRANX) is targeted to an investment in Barrier Free Living Residences, a 120-unit affordable housing property. The housing offers accessible, permanent homes to people with disabilities who are living on limited incomes, are survivors of domestic violence, or are veterans. Barrier Free Living also provides counseling, support groups and safety planning for survivors of domestic violence who have disabilities.
- Administering grants to organizations providing early assistance and crisis management.
- Providing grant support and problem-solving through the Safe & Healthy Churches Initiative. In a partnership with the FaithTrust Institute, we provide tools and resources about how to adequately address the religious issues of domestic violence and child abuse through in-person trainings and webinars.
- Addressing long-term needs through WomenInvest.
